First Eucharist

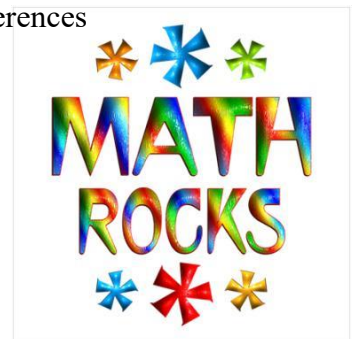
